Our apprentices will be registered on the Science Industry Maintenance Technician or the Healthcare Engineering Specialist Technician Apprenticeship Standard

Qualifications acceptable on entry for engineering are a minimum of GCSE at Grade B/5 in Mathematics and Grade C/4, or equivalent, in at least 4 other subjects to include a science based subject. For construction we are looking a minimum of GCSE at Grade C/4 or equivalent, in at least 4 subjects. The apprenticeships offer a wide range of opportunities to attend specialist courses and gain additional qualifications, over and above the standard apprenticeship.

The apprenticeship will potentially start during the week commencing 30th August 2021 subject to all necessary checks being carried out.
